SAFETY RULES

WALKING UP AND DOWN

Anyone who is obliged to walk up or down a piste must use the edge of the piste, taking care that neither he nor his equipment is a danger to others.

Passing can be done from the front or from the back, from the right or from the left; but it must always be done in a way that is wide enough to prevent the overtaken rider from moving.

RESPECT FOR OTHERS

Users of the slopes must behave in such a way that they cannot endanger or harm others either by their behaviour or by their equipment

SPEED AND BEHAVIOUR CONTROL

All users of the slopes must adapt their speed and behaviour to their personal abilities and to the general conditions of the terrain and weather, the state of the snow and the density of the traffic.

RESPECT FOR INFORMATION, SIGNAGE AND MARKING

The user must take into account the information on the weather conditions, the state of the slopes and the snow. They must respect the signs and markings

AT THE CROSSING OF THE TRACKS OR AT THE START

After stopping or at a crossroads, all users must check upstream and downstream to ensure tha they can proceed without danger to others or to themselves.

CHOICE OF DIRECTION BY THE UPSTREAM PARTY

The person upstream is in a position to choose a trajectory and must make that choice in a way that preserves the safety of anyone downstream.

Any witness or actor in an accident must provide assistance, in particular by sounding the alarm. If necessary and at the request of the first aiders, they must make themselves available to them.

All users must avoid parking in narrow or blind passages; in the event of a fall, they must clea the track as quickly as possible
